- Practice Player Policy
  - Subcommittee met and talked to associations, coaches, etc. Most places allow it usually one or two kids per year.
  - Registration dues: full dues/volunteer hours
  - Board decision with final approval by coaches as not to put coaches in bad situation.
  - o Full participation in all practices but if needed can be asked to sit for a few
  - Written agreement player, family, coach
  - Limiting to a certain number of skaters per year the board reserves the right to limit the number of players approved to do this.
  - Have the skater come before the board
  - Limit to one birth year play up this is the IAHA handbook ie a first Peewee cannot practice with the Bantams.

Create policy - coach has final approval, full dues, adhere to policy (includes volunteer), written agreement with player, family, coaches, limit to a certain number of skaters per year, the board reserves the right to limit the number of players approved, players have to come to the board after coaches approval, limit to one birth year play up. Motion made to approve the policy to be used this year, seconded, passed. Policy will be final on Monday, December 5.
